The History

February has long been a month of romance and although we know that St. Valentine's Day, as we have it today, contains remnants of both Christian and ancient Roman tradition, the actual history of Valentine's Day and its patron saint remains shrouded in mystery.

So, who was Saint Valentine and how did he become associated with this ancient rite? Today, the Catholic Church recognizes at least three different saints named Valentine or Valentinus, all of whom were martyred.

Valentine - The Romantic

One legend contends that Valentine was a priest who served during the third century in Rome. When Emperor Claudius II decided that single men made better soldiers than those with wives and families, he outlawed marriage for young men -- his crop of potential soldiers.

Valentine, realizing the injustice of the decree, defied Claudius and continued to perform marriages for young lovers in secret. When Valentine's actions were discovered, Claudius ordered that he be put to death.

Valentine - The Hero

There are stories that suggest that Valentine may have been killed by the Romans for attempting to help Christians escape harsh Roman prisons, where they were beaten and tortured.

Valentine - The Lover

According to one legend, Valentine actually sent the first 'valentine' greeting himself!

It is believed that Valentine fell in love with a young girl -- who may have been his jailor's daughter. She visited him constantly during his confinement and it is alleged that he wrote her a letter, just before his death, which he signed 'From your Valentine,' an expression that we still use today.

Although the truth behind the Valentine legends is murky, the stories certainly emphasize his appeal as a sympathetic, heroic, and, most importantly, romantic figure. It's no surprise that by the Middle Ages, Valentine was one of the most popular saints in England and France.
